Type of Facility (MC245) Guidance

The Center for Health Information and Analysis (CHIA) has included the Type of Facility field to allow for Present on Admission exemptions as per CMS as well as provide our data users with a succinct way to identify the type of facility associated with a medical claim.

This document will provide guidance only, not rules, on how to assign a code to the type of facility field. As this is based on CMS facility assignments and certifications, carriers may look to CMS for clarification. In some cases links to CMS are provided below.

Type of Facility Indicator	The type of facility setting for the claim.		
Value	Description	Guidance	
1	General Acute Care Facility	A licensed acute care hospital that has not been certified as one of the following types of facilities. (Type of Facility = 2,3,4,5,6,7,8,9)	
2	Skilled Nursing Facility/Long Term Care Facility	A licensed acute care hospital certified as a long term care facility or a licensed nursing home.	
3	Intermediate Care Facility	A licensed or certified intermediate care facility.	
4	Hospice Facility	A licensed hospice facility.	
5	Designated Cancer Center	A licensed acute care hospital certified as a cancer center.	
		In MA it is: Dana-Farber Cancer Institute	
6	Designated Inpatient Children's Hospital	A licensed acute care hospital certified as a children's hospital.	
		In MA it is: Boston Children's Hospital	
7	Inpatient Rehabilitation Facility	A licensed acute care hospital certified as a rehabilitation center.	
8	Inpatient Psychiatric Hospital	A licensed acute care hospital certified as a psychiatric facility.	

9	Critical Access Hospital	A licensed acute care hospital certified as a critical access hospital. In MA there are: Martha's Vineyard Hospital, Fairview Hospital and Athol Memorial Hospital
70	Other Type of Facility	A facility that is not licensed/certified to be one of the facility types listed above (1-9)
