Time Line Changes

FY2015 Case Mix Data in new v2015 Format
Hospital Inpatient Discharge Data (HIDD)
Emergency Department Data (ED)
Outpatient Observation Data (OOA)

FY2015 Quarter 1 Due Date: Extended until April 30, 2015

FY2015 Test Files:

Due weekly until approved for Production



Testing Overview

Case Mix v2015 -Test Filing Period Accepted:

Use filing period **2015 Quarter 1** for v2015 edit testing (10/1/2014 – 12/31/2014).

Sending Test Files to CHIA:

Using **SENDS** and **INET**, Providers should encrypt and upload as normal, **check off that it is a TEST file.** Contact your Liaison to let them know you have uploaded a test file.

Date Issues for test files:

Service Dates that do not fall within the submission period will create errors but will not cause the file to drop.



NEW 30 percent rule for Unknown SSN "00000001"

HIDD, ED, OOA:

The number of Default SSN cannot exceed 30%.

The number of Default Mothers SSN cannot exceed 30%.



CHIA has corrected the error message for the new record length in OOA:

OOA:

There can be no more than 714 (or 686 before 2015) characters per submission line.



When the OOA file is not in the new v2015 format:

OOA: (New record length and number of fields)

Incorrect number of fields. Must be 71 (2007 format) or 72 (2015 format) on each line of the submission.



When the ED file is not in the new v2015 format:

ED: (New record types 50 and 55)

A Record Type 60 (or 50 after 2014) must follow a Record Type 25.

Record type 60 must be preceded with a 55 or another 60.



When the HIDD file is not in the new v2015 format:

HIDD: (New record type 45)

Record Type 40 must be followed by either another Record Type 40 or Record Type 50 (pre 2015) or Record Type 45 (post 2014).

Record Type 50 (pre 2015) or Record Type 45 (post 2014) must follow Record Type 40.



Invalid record length due to incomplete changes in the submission file format:

ED:

All records within the submission file must be 250 characters long.

HIDD:

Every record must have a logical record length of 250 characters and end with a carriage return and line feed.

Record length is not equal 250 characters.
