

16 OF 57 HOSPITALS FULLY **IMPLEMENTED BAR CODE CHECKS DURING MEDICATION ADMINISTRATION** THAT HAVE BEEN SHOWN TO REDUCE MEDICAL ERRORS, AN IMPROVEMENT FROM 2016.

16 OF 57 ACUTE CARE HOSPITALS REPORTED LOWER HEART FAILURE MORTALITY RATES THAN THE NATIONAL MEDIAN.
