

Alternative Payment Methods

I. Review of TAG call summary from 03-05-13

- a. For alternative payment methods, report the payment method and payment dollar amount by member month
- b. Out of state providers must meet 36,000 Massachusetts member month threshold in order to be reported for provider level alternative payment methods.

II. TME Questions to Resolve

- a. Four questions emailed to Payers → updates will be determined by next TAG call

III. Review TME DSM

- a. Changes from previous year filing
 - i. CHIA will clarify that provider level reporting is for MA physician groups for MA members only.

=> Decision: TME provider level reporting is for MA physician groups for MA members only.
 - ii. Insurance category “5” will be added to include other governmental plans, including Senior Care Options, PACE, Bridge, etc. Data for this insurance category will NOT be collected in the submission due on May 1, 2013.

IV. Review RP DSM

- a. Areas to note:
 - i. Payers should report the top 30 physician groups (based on revenue) and aggregate the remaining physician group payments under OrgID 999996.
 - ii. Other providers below the 3% revenue threshold should be reported in a single aggregate line under the appropriate aggregate OrgID for each respective organization type.
 - iii. Page 6 of RP DSM – Service Mix and Product Mix definitions are changed to “service/product mix is the percentage of claims payments to a provider attributed to each service/product type.”
 - iv. Service and Product mix should each sum to 100% within each organization type.
