MA APCD Intake

- All APCD submissions through April 2022 were due by May 31st. This includes any re-submissions.
- Please work with your liaison in submitting any overdue files and alert them if you expect any further delays.
- Data will be used towards Q2 2022 DOI membership and other quarterly reporting.
- CHIA is revisiting Medical Claim versioning methods with select payers. We'll reach out when we have examples to share with each company.

MA APCD – 2022 Provider Submission Guide Update (Page 9)

Specification Question	Clarification	Rationale
Should inactive providers be included on the file and what is the reporting time period?	Yes, all providers, both active and inactive must be included. Providers that were inactive prior to January 2010 2015 are not to be included. It is necessary to report <u>any and all</u> provider information that aligns to the eligibility and claims data to insure that linking between files can occur.	CHIA collects the most up to date provider data that can be used to analyze claims data. Since claims data is collected monthly, the provider file can be synced with the claims <u>file, and</u> can be a snapshot of how the provider file looked at the end of the period for which claims are sent.
