

Massachusetts Acute Hospital and Health System Financial Performance

Fiscal Year Data through June 30, 2019

About this Report

The Center for Health Information and Analysis (CHIA) reports on the financial performance of the Commonwealth's acute care hospitals, associated hospital health systems (HHS), and affiliated physician organizations. This report provides a quarterly update on profitability, liquidity, and solvency for the period ending June 30, 2019. Data regarding HHS and physician organizations help develop a more complete understanding of the financial performance of an acute hospital in the context of the larger health system within which it operates. This report includes 21 of the 23 HHS required to submit data. Cambridge Health Alliance and Trinity Health are not included in this report as they have a June 30 fiscal year end and as such, their data is not due until October. Steward Health Care did not submit the required HHS or physician organization data; however Steward did submit hospital data. Lawrence General Hospital and Affiliates did not submit the required HHS, hospital, or physician organization data in time to be included in this report.

Key Findings

Profitability - Hospitals

Overall acute hospital profitability¹, as measured by the median total margin, decreased by 1.4 percentage points in comparison to the same period of the prior year. The AMC², teaching, and community hospital cohorts³ experienced increased median total margins. Only the community-HPP cohort reported a decrease in median total margin of 1 percentage point.


Liquidity

All hospital cohorts reported a median current ratio above 1.0, an indication that they have sufficient current assets to meet current liabilities. The 12 hospitals that reported ratios below 1.0 are all part of larger health systems. All 21 hospital health systems that reported data had current ratios above 1.0.

Solvency

A negative net asset position indicates that total liabilities are greater than the hospital's total assets. Four hospitals reported negative net assets in the current period. All of the hospital health systems that reported data had positive net assets.



Profitability – Hospital Health Systems and Physician Organizations

Of the 21 hospital health systems that reported data, 17 reported a profit. Of the 4 HHS that reported a loss, 3 had at least one hospital that was profitable. The majority of HHS affiliated physician organizations (37 out of 43) reported a net loss.

The data included in this report reflects third quarter performance for the majority of the hospital health systems.

*Shriners Hospital Boston (SHB) and Shriners Hospital Springfield are part of the national Shriners Hospitals for Children system (SHC) and are reliant upon support from the HSC endowment to cover the costs associated with fulfilling their mission to provide care to patients regardless of their ability to pay. This support is provided through transfers from the SHC's endowment to the hospitals, as these transfers are not considered revenue for the purpose of calculating profitability margin, SHB's and SHS's profitability margins are not comparable to other acute hospitals. Therefore, they have been excluded from the graphics but are included in the statewide median and the databook.
