# Release 2.0 Highlights

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- Dates of service CY12 paid thru 6/30/13
- Versioning for seven large carriers
- Reassignment of multiple data elements to different release levels (i.e. Level 2 or 3) to ensure patient privacy
- Updated data from prior years
- MassHealth ISA Signed!

# Release 2.1

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- Expected release date Apr 30<sup>th</sup>
- More versioning
- Master Patient Index

# Application Updates

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- Non-Government
  - Fee Information
  - Type of Entity/Applicable Regulatory Process
  - Medicaid/Medicare Data
  - Data Security
- Government
  - Project Summary
  - Medicaid/Medicare Data
  - Data Security

# Data Security and Integrity

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Changes on both Governmental Non-governmental applications:

- New and legacy questions now grouped into ten (10) logical sections (Technical safeguards, Administrative Safeguards, et al)
- New questions:
  - *Specific physical location where data will be housed*
  - *Data Privacy Training and Awareness*
  - *Encryption of copied data*
  - *Software Applications Accessing the Data*
  - *Audit log on system accessing data*
  - *Unique user accounts*
  - *Standard A/V at current version*
  - *Physical security features of room housing server holding data*

# Data Security and Integrity

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Added questions unique to either application:

## Governmental

- *Compliant with EO504 (state) or FISMA (federal)*
- *Enterprise Information Security questions (for information security person)*

## Non-governmental

- *Cyber security awareness training in last 2 years*
- *Breach of PHI or PII in last 7 years*
- *Last risk assessment*
- *Last audit*

# Medicaid Data Update

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- To request Medicaid data:
  - Check the box on the application
  - Provide support that work is “directly connected” to the administration of Medicaid
- MassHealth Review – “Directly Connected”
  - 30-day goal for response
  - MassHealth may impose additional requirements
- Default substance abuse filter is applied to all requests



# Medicare Data Update

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- To request Medicare data:
  - Only available to state agencies and/or entities directed and partially funded by the state
  - Check the box on the application
  - Complete the Medicare data request form (available on IRBNet)
- Applicants must execute the Medicare Addendum to CHIA's Data Use Agreement (available on IRBNet)

# Claims Versioning Update

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- Goal: Use the highest version claim lines to produce accurate cost and utilization measures for each payer and for the Commonwealth
- Background: CHIA has standard versioning logic, based on the APCD data submission guides:
  - 1) Applies cleaning logic
  - 2) Identifies duplicates, voids/back-outs, and replacements/amendments
  - 3) Sets highest version flag

# Claims Versioning Update



- Hypothetical example of claims history:

Payer Claim Control Number	Line Counter	Version Number	Claim Line Type	Claim Status	Procedure Code	Charge Amount	Paid Amount	Date of Service From
MZ110228E5331	1	0	O	1	99401	\$ 50.00	\$ 25.00	2/17/2011
MZ110228E5331	1	1	B	22	99401	\$ 50.00	\$ (25.00)	2/17/2011
MZ110228E5331	1	2	A	1	99401	\$ 50.00	\$ 30.00	2/17/2011

# Claims Versioning Update

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- Since last summer, CHIA's liaisons and QA analysts have been working closely with selected carriers to
  - 1) Review if the CHIA standard logic apply and if any deviations
  - 2) Examine deviations and find agreeable solutions
  - 3) Implement and validate carrier-specific versioning logic
  
- Highest Version Flag in Release 2.0:
  - 0 – Not the highest version
  - 1 – Highest version
  - 9 – Not Versioned

# Claims Versioning Update

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- Medical claims versioned for the following seven carriers (included in Release 2.0):
  - ✓ Blue Cross Blue Shield of Massachusetts
  - ✓ Boston Medical Center HealthNet Plan
  - ✓ ConnectiCare of Massachusetts, Inc.
  - ✓ Fallon Community Health
  - ✓ Harvard Pilgrim Health Care
  - ✓ Network Health
  - ✓ Tufts Health Plan
- Future releases will include versioning for pharmacy and dental claims and for other large carriers.
